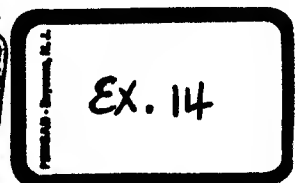
Re Silver and Murphy - CS5 despatch

Re U.S. Justice PRS

Quite frankly this is quite difficult to understand due to sloppy reporting and poor co-ordination. Your last despatch does not really enlighten me as there are legal actions referred to which are unknown at w/w.

The strategy is as follows:

- 1) Silver arranges for and has a meeting with the US attorney & confesses his sins and says that he did it as a prank.
- 2) at the meeting Silver waives his right to a grand Jury indictment, so as to get a speedy sentence & to get it over.
- 3) The US attorneys then would file one information with the Court concerning specific charges.
- 4) Silver would then go before the Judge within 10 days - plead guilty and, as it's his first offence, get sentenced lightly on the spot. Hopefully, he would get a month or suspended sentence.



Just in case, they refuse to file information and press for a grand Jury investigation, he has a privilege because he has already been arrested and may refuse to testify at all before a grand Jury.

What research has to be done on what laws?

Please write a detailed report which actually answers these questions and gives the specifics on the problems with Silver's lawyers.
